- The Government of Kenya has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Kenya Digital Economy Acceleration Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Supply, Delivery & Commissioning of Interactive Digital Content for Competency Based Curriculum for Grade 9. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit.
- The Information and Communications Technology Authority (ICTA) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Supply, Delivery & Commissioning of Interactive Digital Content for Competency Based Curriculum for Grade 9: Lot 1: English, Lot 2: Kiswahili, Lot 3: Mathematics, Lot 4: Integrated Science, Lot 5: Agriculture, Lot 6: Creative Arts & Sports, Lot 7: Christian Religious Education, Lot 8: Islamic Religious Education, Lot 9: Hindu Religious Education & Lot 10: Social Studies – Technical Studies. The location of the assignment is at Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development and will be for a period of six (6) months.
